Reproductive Health Services, Guatemala

Founded in 2001, WINGS Guatemala provides quality reproductive health education and services to underserved, primarily rural Guatemalan youth, women, and men.



In Guatemala, 47% of children under five are chronically malnourished (80% in Indigenous populations) and 80% of the Indigenous population lives in poverty.

Healthcare

Providing reproductive health services is fundamental to breaking the cycles of

poverty and inequality that are present in Guatemala. Without the ability to plan and space pregnancies, families are often unable to meet the basic needs of all their family members. Increased access to family planning methods has been linked to better nutritional outcomes, increased educational attainment for girls, decreased migration, and decreased environmental implications. When women control their own pace of reproduction, they are able to make decisions to pursue education, join the workforce and delay marriage if desired.

Approach

Working in 14 predominantly rural, indigenous, and underserved provinces in Guatemala, WINGS takes a holistic approach to reproductive health and collaborates with local partners to implement the following activities:

- Youth Peer Education Program Training youth leaders to provide accurate reproductive health information and service referrals to their peers.
- Volunteer Promoter Network
- Reproductive Health Clinics
- Mobile Surgical Clinics

World Centric provided 3.2% of the total cost for WINGS reproductive health services in 2021. Their programs will provide tubal ligations, vasectomies, birth control and emergency contraception to rural Guatemalans.

Donation to support low-income and immigrant women entrepreneurs

ALLOCATION: \$3,400 | FISCAL YEAR: 2020



La Cocina, or "The Kitchen" in Spanish, is a nonprofit in San Francisco's Mission District working to solve problems of equity in business ownership for women, immigrants and people of color.

Financial Assistance

Working class women-of-color and immigrant women, many of whom are skilled cooks, have traditionally been excluded from the

formal job market in the foodservice industry. In the U.S., women account for only 33% of business owners nationwide and still make just 46-75 cents for every dollar their white, male counterparts.

This is where La Cocina comes in. La Cocina provides low-income and immigrant women food entrepreneurs with affordable commercial kitchen space, industryspecific technical assistance, access to market

opportunities, and other resources needed to survive the crucial start-up phase of a foodservice operation. The La Cocina incubator kitchen is home to more than 40 upand-coming businesses that represent dozens of diverse cultures through food.

In the spring of 2021, La Cocina opened the Municipal Marketplace - a 7,000 square foot food hall in the Tenderloin that houses seven women-owned businesses.

One entrepreneur in La Cocina's marketplace is Nafy Ba Flatley, founder of Teranga (which means hospitality in Wolof, her native Senegalese language). Nafy started her career in marketing in San Francisco, but found an increasing passion in raising three kids on the flavorful, healthy food of her childhood. Her Senegalese village was built around a baobab tree, and Nafy remembered drinking the bright, refreshing bissap baobab as a child. She now bottles the energizing drink and makes delicious Pan-African meals.

The Marketplace provides economic opportunity for La Cocina entrepreneurs, a welcoming space, jobs for the community, and delicious and affordable food.

Donation to support ongoing coastal protection efforts

ALLOCATION: \$10,000 | FISCAL YEAR: 2020



WILDCOAST is an international organization working with communities to conserve and protect coastal and marine ecosystems in California and Mexico.

Conservation

In Mexico, WILDCOAST has a project capturing and recycling plastic waste from the Tijuana River before it ends up

in the ocean. They installed a "trash boom" along the river which acts as a physical barrier to capture trash and prevent it from moving further downstream while allowing the water to continue flowing. Since January, WILDCOAST's boom has captured over 10,000 pounds of plastic waste. They are able to recycle 93% of what is captured.

"As all of that water moves through the canyons predominantly in Mexico, it is being carried to the Tijuana River which empties directly into the southernmost marine protected area in California," explains Lisa Gilfillan, Ocean Conservation & Education Coordinator.

Now, WILDCOAST is working with community members in the canyon to reduce pollution. Border Coordinator Rosario Norzagaray organizes recycling events with

ECOCE, another civil organization, where people are able to exchange plastic waste for foods such as rice, beans, milk, and juice.

And the recently implemented collection points in the Los Laureles neighborhood allow people to participate directly in the recycling campaigns, collecting over 800 pounds of plastic in a single month.



Our society has an urgent need for more widespread commercial composting facilities to keep food waste out of landfills, where it does harm to the environment by releasing methane, one of the most potent greenhouse gases. Across North America, many restaurants are discovering small-scale community composters that are stepping up to help local residents and foodservice operators reduce their waste.

V + B vegetable

Ariane Valle (the vegan) met Turner Hoff (the paleo), and in 2016 V+B was born. A subscription-based service, V+B delivers chef designed, dietitian approved, prepared meals throughout Washington D.C.

"We started V+B because we were tired of mediocre food that was marginally healthy, tired of yo-yo'ing between diets that were difficult to sustain, and most importantly, tired of the single-use plastics and plastic packaging that are destroying our planet," explain Ariane and Turner. "We knew we could do better."

V+B's mission is to help people reestablish a meaningful connection with food that is sourced with the seasons, and prepared with complete transparency.

"One of our core values is being kind to the earth, which is why we use World Centric compostable containers plus reusable bags and ice packs for all of our meal deliveries," explain Ariane and Turner. "From the farmers of our ingredients to the suppliers of our compostable packaging, we work hard to establish lasting relationships with people who share our values and care about the environmental impacts of their businesses." V+B uses only compostable foodservice ware from World Centric. Customers can request a compostable bag every Monday with their meal delivery, fill it up with containers, lids and sleeves, and give it back the following week. All packaging is diverted and composted by Compost Cab. In March 2021, V+B composted 11,388 meal containers, saving 1,196 pounds of packaging waste from the landfill.

V+B also partners with Food Rescue and Food Not Bombs to minimize food waste and donate meals to those in need. In the same month, V+B donated 1,172 meals, preventing 952 pounds of food waste. Learn more at vegetableandbutcher.com.



Compost Cab is a pioneer in communitybased composting. Launched by Jeremy Brosowsky in 2010 as a local soil-exchange program in Washington, D.C., today the company diverts tons of organic material from landfills every day.




Our third party verifications and testing

Sustainable Materials

The materials we use to make our compostable packaging are chosen for their sustainability. Our paper containers and molded fiber products are made from annually renewable plants such as bamboo, sugarcane bagasse and wheat straw, which also sequester carbon while growing. Paper cups, straws and bowls are made from sustainably sourced paper from FSC[®] certified sources.

Waste Reduction

When commercially composted, our foodservice ware diverts organic waste from the landfill and composts in 2-4 months. When compostable packaging is accepted, more food waste ends up in the compost where it belongs. Composting also keeps waste disposal local and creates jobs in the local economy. Composting is a great way to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve soil health.
